We encourage all residents to attend activities throughout the day. For the month of August, we will be giving an extra \$1,000 in funny money for every friend you bring to an activity.



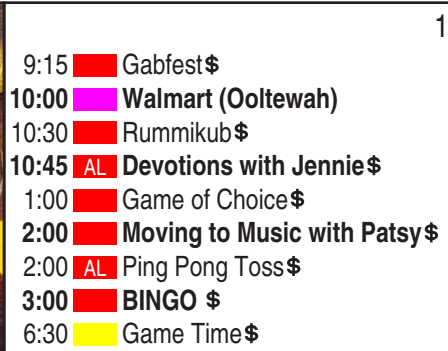
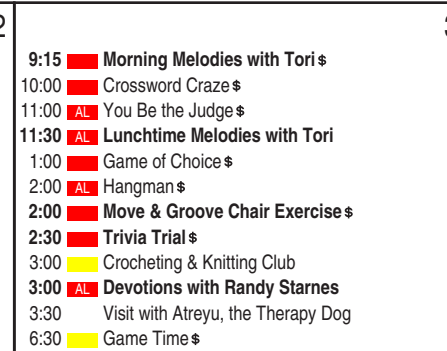
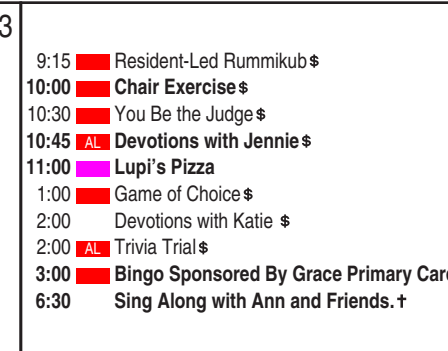
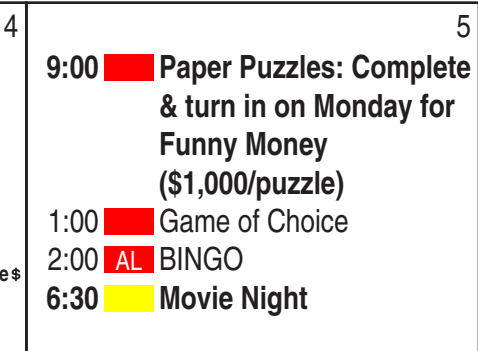
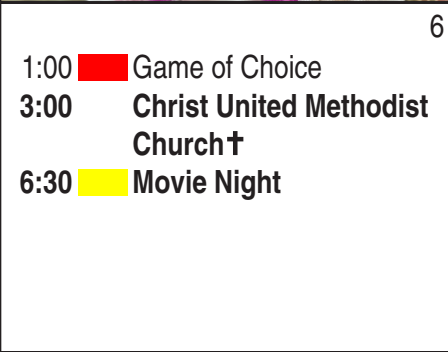
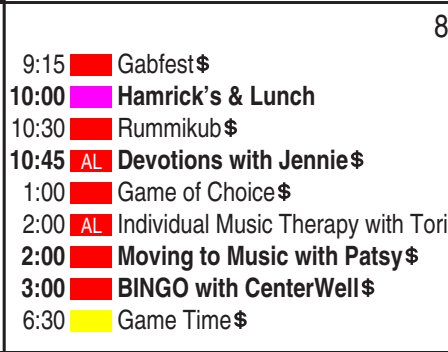
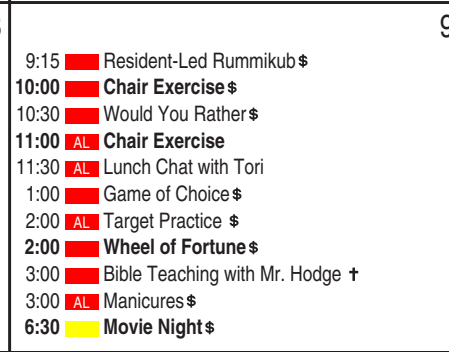
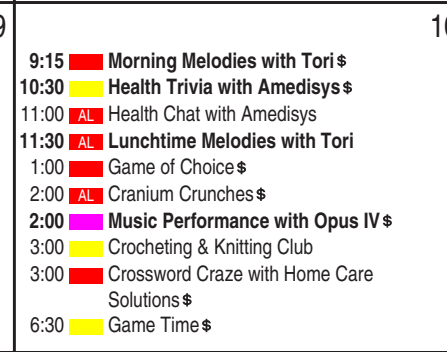
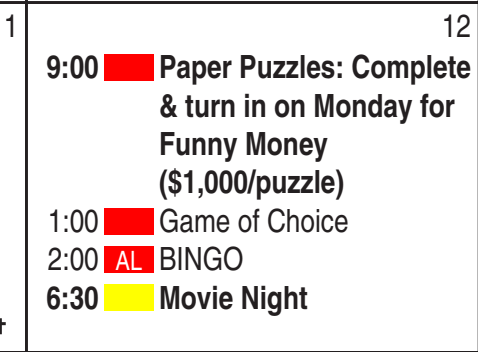
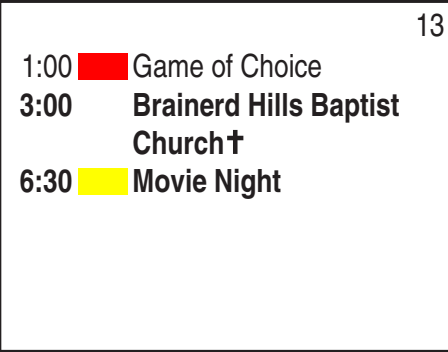
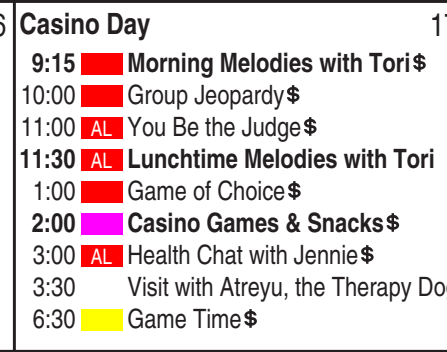
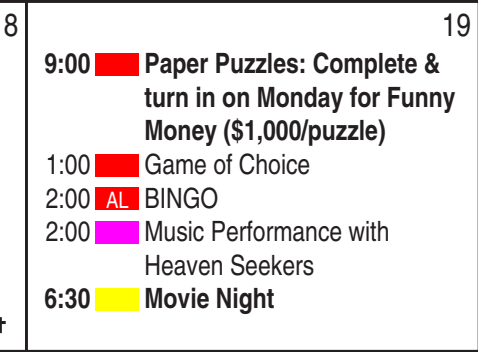
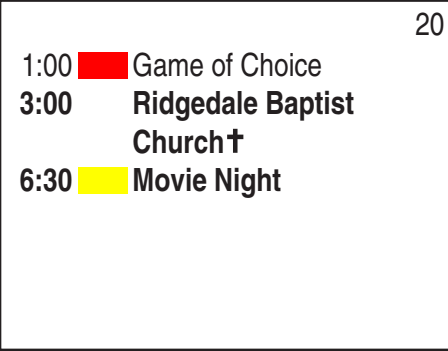
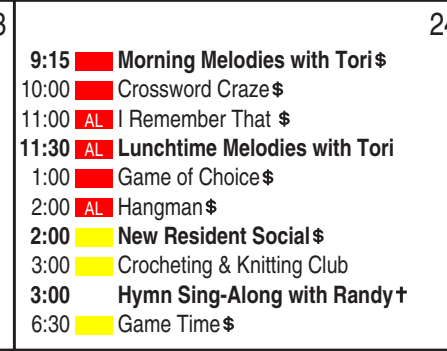
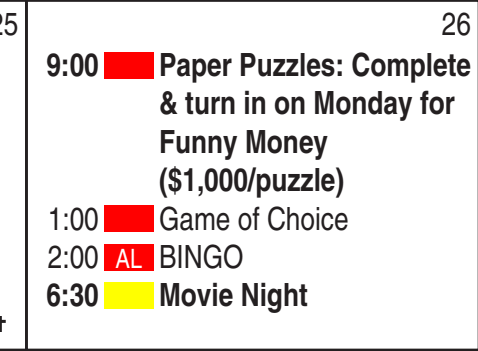
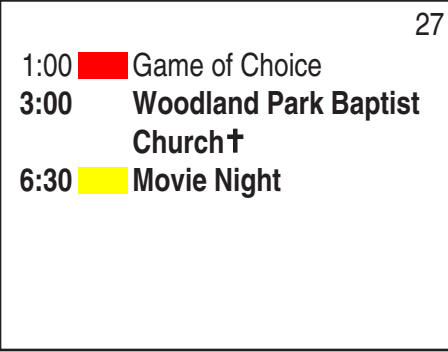
Game Of Choice

Activity Department Suggestion Box

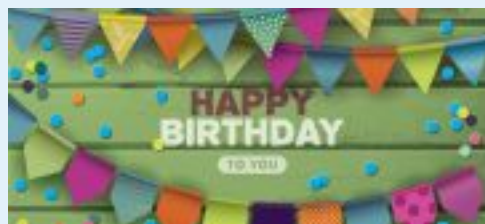
