Happy Juneteenth

Commemorating the end of slavery in the U.S., Juneteenth takes place on June 19 every year. On that date in 1865, U.S. troops arrived in Galveston, Texas, the western-most state at the time, to announce the end of the Civil War. The following year, formerly enslaved people celebrated the anniversary as Jubilee Day, and the festive tradition spread through the remaining states, eventually becoming a federal holiday.



Famous Firsts: Father's Day

Inspired by the campaign to create the Mother's Day holiday, Sonora Smart Dodd of Spokane, Washington, wanted to designate a day for dads to honor her father, a Civil War veteran and widower who single-handedly raised his six children. She lobbied businesses and government officials, and on June 19, 1910, the state of Washington observed the nation's first Father's Day. The celebration gained popularity, but it didn't become a permanent holiday until 1972, when President Richard M. Nixon signed the law designating the third Sunday in June as Father's Day.



Slurp Up a Taste of Summer

A snow cone is a classic summertime treat. Depending on where you live, the cool concoction may be called a different name, such as a snowball or shaved ice, and vary in the consistency of the "snow," or ice, but it's usually topped with brightly colored syrups in fruity flavors.
